



Yawgoog 2010

Sunday July 11, 2010 thru Sunday July 18, 2010
Camp Yawgoog - Rockville, RI

Departure: We will depart from the Floral Park railroad station, opposite the Floral Park Library at 1:00 PM on Sunday, July 11, 2010. Please get to the train station **45 minutes early**, at 12:15 PM. Please eat lunch before arriving at the bus! Sandwiches will be provided for dinner at the Camp on Sunday evening.

Transportation: Will be by coach bus for scouts, and via private vehicle for adult leaders staying with the Troop. Those adults attending camp will receive a confirmation of the dates of their scheduled stay at camp along with directions and any troop equipment we may ask you to bring.

Important Rules: All of the policies and procedures of the Boy Scouts of America are in effect and enforced at Yawgoog. There are certain things that are not allowed at Yawgoog including Scouts with cell phones. **Please do not let your son bring a cell phone to camp.** Troop 482 will enforce the camp rules and not allow scouts to have cell phones. If a scout has a phone, it will be confiscated and returned to him at the end of the week on the bus ride home. If you need to get in contact with your son you will be able to get one of the adult leaders via cell phone or you can leave a message at the camp office. Some areas of camp have poor or no cell service.

Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. If it becomes necessary, we will call you and ask you to come pick up your son.

Age Requirements – The troop leadership will enforce the camp rules in regards to age requirements for certain activities, for instance:

Rifle Shooting - Scouts must be 14 years of age or older and the parent must have signed off on the permission slip they submitted to allow their son to shoot.

Shotgun Shooting - Scouts must be 15 years of age or older and the parent must have signed off on the permission slip they submitted to allow their son to shoot.

Challenge Center (rope climbing activities) - Scouts must be 14 years of age or older except for Adventure I (AI) which is open to scouts 10-13.

Kayaking - Scouts must be 13 years of age or older.

Electronics - please do not allow your son to bring a cell phone to camp. Troop 482 will enforce the camp rules and not allow scouts to have cell phones. If a scout has a phone, it will be confiscated and returned to him at the end of the week on the bus ride home. If your son brings an ipod, mp3 player, CD player, radio, etc he will be allowed to use it with headphones (earplugs) during downtime in his bunk. We will not allow boys to be walking around the camp or our campsite using these devices. Your help in explaining this to your son in advance would be appreciated.
